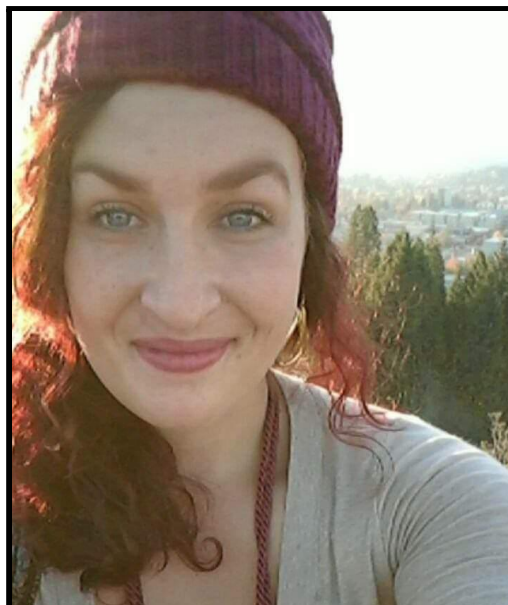
## Honor Ivory McCuen
